January Shoot

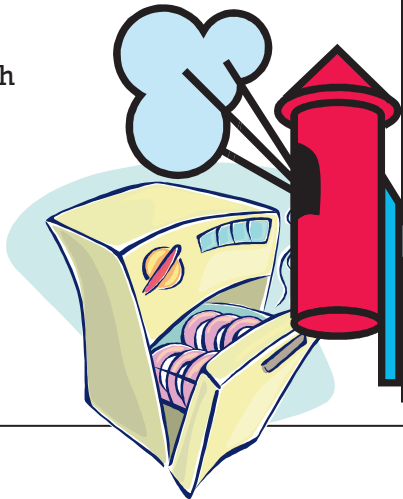
The theme for the shoot in November will be "Clean as a whistle".
